

## **Peshastin Community Council**

November 7, 2011

Peshastin Legion Hall

Steve called the meeting to order, Brian moved to approve the minutes of the last meeting with a change to Cascade rather than Peshastin High School, Cheryl seconded and it was passed unanimously. June reported \$595.08 in the treasury.

Steve has talked to Dan Mayfield and Dan will talk to the County about the missing sign at the intersection. Brian said there is one sign on the other side of the road and it's his understanding the County will not place a second sign at the intersection.

June reported the sign at the end of the bridge will have to be taken down in order to refurbish it. Steve will take another look to see what may be done.

Tricia, Cheryl and Karen Smith picked up 4 black bags of garbage at the intersection on cleanup day. Thanks to them for their effort.

Steve read the letter, copy enclosed that he wrote to the County concerning the rooster complaint. Glennia said the County has said she must remove her chickens and she would like the Council to look into rewriting the code to allow chickens and rabbits on less than one-quarter acre lots. The Council agreed to look at her suggestions and see if we want to pursue this matter.

Phil Mosher, Chief of Fire District #6 gave the council a review of why the fire district would like to increase their tax levy to begin replacing trucks and equipment. Fire District #6 includes Valley Hi, Peshastin, Dryden, unincorporated Cashmere and Monitor. They receive about 300 calls per year. The District owns 10 acres in Dryden and has plans to build a new fire station on 5 acres and the other 5 acres will be surplused.

Kathy went over plans for the Santa Pancake Breakfast to be held on December 10<sup>th</sup>.

Cheryl moved to adjourn the meeting, June seconded and it was passed unanimously.
